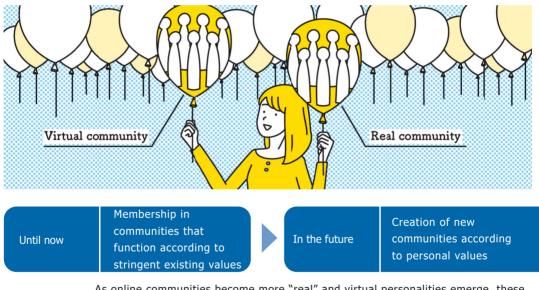


## Choose or build your own community
